



PARENTAL CONSENT FORM & RELEASE

The AIM Gaming Center supports the ESRB Industry rating system for computer and video games, along with the voluntary enforcement of the rating system. Any participant who will not be at least 18 years of age on the day they arrive at AIM Gaming Center must have parental consent to be admitted into the Aim Gaming Center. Minors under the age of 13 are not eligible to attend events or partake in any open hours at the AIM Gaming Center. However, children under the age of 13 may access the facility if part of a supervised private event, such as a birthday party or exclusive group booking. Parents or guardians of children attending such private events must complete the consent form and remain responsible for ensuring compliance with the Gaming Center rules and guidelines during the event.

Should your child or legal ward need medical attention, you can authorize us to call an ambulance. You agree to release, waive, and discharge, and covenant not to sue the AIM Gaming Center, its parents, affiliates, successors, officers, directors, employees, agents, and sponsors from all liabilities for any all loss or damaged property or injury to persons (including without limitation to your child / legal ward), and any claim or demands therefore, arising out of or in any manner related to your minor child / legal ward’s attendance at the AIM Gaming Center’s events / open hours, regardless of whether caused by the negligence of Aim Gaming Center, its employees, agents, or otherwise.
